



Location

BeLonG To Youth Services is based at the heart of Dublin City, on 13 Parliament Street in the capital's famous Temple Bar. As you turn on to Parliament Street from the quays, our offices are on the street's left-hand side, tucked away above the Fish Shack Café. Dublin Castle is a 2-minute walk away, and there are several accessible transport links to our service.



Public Transport

Right outside our door is the Parliament Street bus stop which serves the 69, 79/79a, and 860 busses from the southside of the city. We are also just across Grattan Bridge from Ormond Quay and next to Dame Street, all of which have bus stops serving buses from right across the city.

The Jervis Street Luas stop is just a 5-minute walk away, and the Red Luas Line links to both Connolly and Heuston station if you're travelling by train.

To get to us from Jervis Street LUAS Stop, you can follow the street towards the river Liffey, down Swift's Row, take a right on to Ormond Quay and then left across Grattan Bridge and straight ahead Parliament Street.

Cycling

There are several bike racks along Parliament Street for cyclists to lock their bicycles securely.

By Car

If you are travelling to us by car from elsewhere in the country, we are between a 20- and 30-minute drive from all significant M50 exits, and the nearest car park to our building is the Jervis Street Carpark, next to the Luas stop.

Suppose you are parking on the south side of the river. In that case, the closest carpark is the Trinity Street Carpark, a 5-minute walk from our building, turning left from the carpark onto Trinity Street, another left onto Dame Street, and then taking the fifth right turn onto Parliament Street opposite the City Hall building.
